

# LIVE Online Math Pacing Guide for Pre-Pre-Algebra Video Course

Please keep in mind that these are general ideas and any suggested time frames are not meant to be taken as being hard deadlines. One of the beauties of a video course is the ability to work at the student's pace!

## General Ideas About Pacing...

- For many students, completing 3 lessons per week is reasonable. Of course, quizzes and tests may be outside of this estimate.
- Units 2-4 (primarily about fractions) are foundational and should really be done well.
- Unit 5 (on decimals) tends to be easy for some students, but difficult for others, depending on the student's background experience. It may be wise to plan for this to take a while.
- Even though Unit 7 has 8 lessons (tied for most in the course), those lessons generally tend to be on the easier side of things.
- Unit 12 tends to not take very much time.

## Sample Schedule/Milestones (Traditional School Year – September through May)...

- By Thanksgiving: Complete units 1-4
- By Christmas/New Year's: Complete unit 5
- By early April (Spring Break): Complete units 6-9
- By the end of May: Complete units 10-12

## Sample Schedule/Milestones (Year Round Schooling Starting in September)...

- By Thanksgiving: Complete units 1-3
- By Christmas/New Year's: Complete unit 4
- By the end of February: Complete units 5 and 6
- By the end of May: Complete units 7-9
- By the 4th of July: Complete unit 10
- By the end of August: Complete units 11 and 12
